Directions to Anvil Ranch and Vineyard

Travel Time to Anvil Ranch (likely will take longer due to wine festival weekend):

- 2 ½ hours from San Francisco
- 1 1/2 hours from Santa Rosa
- 1 hour from Healdsburg

The last 40 minutes of the drive are on a single lane windy country road and is poorly marked and poorly lit, it is best driven in daylight. Cell phone reception is nearly non-existent past Healdsburg.

Directions from San Francisco or the East Bay:

- 1. Find your way to Hwy 101 and head North.
- 2. After about 1 ½ hrs, you'll pass the town of "Santa Rosa" and then you'll see signs for Healdsburg. (As mentioned, stop in Healdsburg if you need to pick up items from the grocery store, or if you have less than a 1/2 tank of gas.
- 3. If you need to stop, take the Central Healdsburg exit to go to the grocery store (Safeway), or a gas station.
- 4. The next exit is Dry Creek Rd. exit. Take this exit and turn left onto Dry Creek Rd. (There are two other gas stations, if you turn right onto Dry Creek Rd.)
- 5. Reset your odometer to zero. At about 3.2 miles, or about 4 minutes, you will come to a stop sign. (The small "Dry Creek general store" will be on your right.)
 - Continue straight through the stop sign, staying on Dry Creek Rd.
- 6. At approximately 9.5 miles, or 13 minutes from when you exited 101, you will pass Sbragia winery on your right.
- 7. Soon after, the road will make a sharp left turn. The road now becomes Skaggs Springs Rd, and Sonoma Lake will be on your right. Continue onward.
- 8. Within 3 to 5 more minutes, or 11.7 miles since exiting Hwy 101, you will make a LEFT TURN onto Stewarts Point Skaggs Springs Rd. BE READY FOR THIS LEFT TURN!
- 9. This sign is on the right side of the road make a LEFT at this sign:



- 10. The Ranch entrance is about 35 minutes away--or exactly 20 more miles (32 since exiting Hwy 101)--from this sign. You are getting close when you pass Hillside Ranch on your left. The Anvil Ranch is about 10 minutes, or 5 miles, past the Hillside Ranch.
- 11. You will see the sign for Anvil Ranch painted on a huge log on your right. There is also a long, white wooden horse fence and a white barn behind it on the right. Turn LEFT across the road. At the driveway gate enter the code: **2704**

To continue to the houses, ceremony, and picnic area (Anvil Ranch Guest Houses):

- You will continue up this road until you come to a small, tan booth that looks like an outhouse. Make a sharp LEFT turn and continue up the driveway. (Just one more mile to the ranch guest houses.) Follow the signs from here.
- When you start driving on a downgrade you will soon see the white Main House on your left. Park opposite that house in the "Visitor Parking" lot on the right for both the wedding and the picnic.
